

## Miras Jovem Trousseau Nouveau 2015

### Viticulture:

- Region: Patagonia, Argentina.
- Province: Río Negro.
- Sub-Region: Alto Valle del Río Negro.
- Locality: Guerrico.
- Variety: Trousseau.
- Year of planting: 1977.
- Yield: 10,000 kg/ha.
- Harvest: Manual harvesting in boxes of 15 kg.

### Vinification and Aging:

- Red Wine made with the technique of traditional fermentation with delestage.
- 18 days of maceration.
- Fermentation temperature: 25 ° C.
- Malolactic fermentation: complete.
- Clarification: with fresh egg albumin.
- Unfiltered Bottling.
- Number of Bottles: 3,000.
- Aging in bottle: 2 months minimum at the winery before shipment to market.
- Cellaring Potential: 2 or more years.

### Analytical Data:

- Alcohol: 14.5 v/v.
- Residual Sugar: 1.78 g/l.
- Total Acidity: 5.77 g/l.
- pH: 3.6.

### Tasting Notes:

This unique wine's translucent ruby colour conceals a surprise on the palate. But first on the nose, it has a beautifully complex fruity aroma in which currant, blueberry, strawberry, guava and cherry can be detected, along with earthy, minty, and herbal notes. On the palate, for a wine of such delicate colour, it has an unexpectedly robust tannic structure, with balanced fruit-forwardness and freshness, with a bit of sweetness too. These sensations persist on the long finish.
