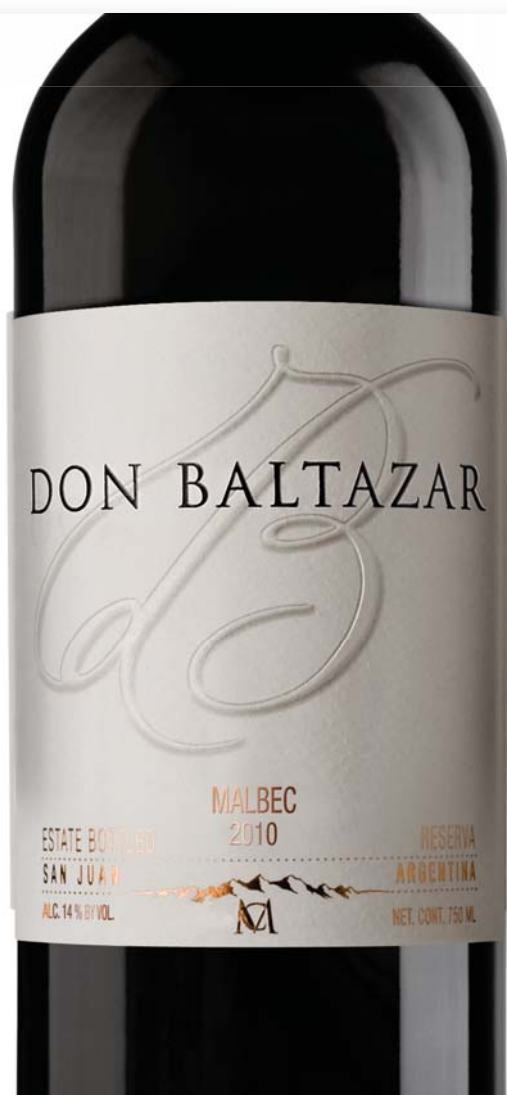


DON BALTAZAR

The deep purple colour and tastes of plums, cherries and sweet spice with vanilla and caramel flavours, best express the signature grape of Argentina. Aged 09 months in French and American oak barrels, this generous and full bodied wine is best accompanied with red meat. Vineyard height: 2,500 feet above sea level. Canopy system: Smart Dyson V.P.S.

Year: 2010.

Date of harvest: March, second fortnight.

Conduction: espalier system.

Irrigation: by dripping with meltwater from the Cordillera de los Andes.

Harvest: manually, in boxes.

Maceration: traditional.

Varietal: 100% Malbec

Residual sugar: 4,00 g/l.

Dry extract: 32.49 g.

Production: 8.000 cases x 12 bottles.
